DIABLO WEST TENNIS RULES

- 1. Admission to Courts:** Admission is restricted to Diablo West Association members and guest(s) only, who must have a key in their possession. Please keep gates locked to prevent access by non-members.
- 2. Guests:** A Diablo West resident must be present and may have no more than three guest players, with play restricted to one court.
- 3. Junior Players:** Children under age 16 are considered Junior Players. Junior Players have equal privileges to adults on Court 1 at all times. Junior Players must surrender other courts to adults on Saturday, Sunday, Holidays and after 6:00 P.M. unless they are playing with an adult resident.
- 4. Saving Courts:** One person cannot hold a vacant court. One person may hold a waiting position for his or her group, but the group must be ready to start play when the court is vacated or their place is forfeited.
- 5. Playing While Others Are Waiting:** Play will be limited to one hour when others are waiting for a court.
- 6. Waiting Rules:** Waiting players should wait quietly on the benches. Loud talking, hitting balls against the fence, or behavior annoying to active players is prohibited.
- 7. Children:** Children are the responsibility of the attending adult and shall not be left unattended at any time. Children of players are not allowed on the courts during play and must remain outside the courts.
- 8. Reservations:** Residents may make reservations with the Association to use the courts for challenges and tournaments. Call the clubhouse office at 831- 9045 or email George Cooper at georgewcooper@msn.com to place your reservation.
- 9. Footwear:** Footwear is strictly limited to rubber soled shoes that will not mark or damage the court surfaces.
- 10. Court Restrictions:** Use of bikes, skateboards, roller blades, or any other type of wheeled toy is strictly prohibited. No glass containers, dogs or other pets are allowed on the courts.
- 11. Court Etiquette:** Standard tennis etiquette is to be observed at all times. Consideration of players on other courts is common courtesy. Persons who are not practicing reasonable consideration and court etiquette may be asked to leave the courts by any resident and will be reported to the Board of Directors.
- 12. Commercial Use:** The tennis courts are not to be used for personal profit by any resident without prior approval of the Board of Directors.
